

Figures were released during the regular meeting of Grant City Council on Tuesday, June 12 for water use during the month of May, along with lotto sales last month.

- Water: The month of May figures for water use included consumption of 28,781,000 gallons of water. This is an increase from the previous month of April of 18,668,000 gallons.

The figure is also a large increase over May's figure one year ago during a time when there was a lot of spring rain. There were 16,488,400 more gallons of water used in May 2012 than in May 2011.

- Lotto: Sales of lotto at DJ's Bar and Grill totaled \$5,578.90 for the month of May. Payout totaled \$2,714.95 for a net of \$2,863.95.

There was an amount of \$8 left unclaimed.
