Seventy-Five Years Ago

Oct. 13, 1938

A survey of 300,000 families representing an accurate cross section of this country's population reveals that almost one-third of all families and single individuals in the country had an income of less than \$750 during the year 1935-36. More than 69 percent received less than \$1500. Only two percent had incomes over \$5000, and less than one percent had incomes of \$10,000

and over.
