



Venango and Grant firefighters battled a machinery fire near Brandon on Sept. 26 which destroyed a fairly new baler belonging to farmer Loren Jessen. According to Venango Fire Chief Steve Tucker, the tractor was probably salvageable. The field was already swathed and mostly baled before a bearing went out causing a hot spark that lit material in the baler, he said.
