

As the Husker football team opens its 2011 season, including entering the Big Ten Conference, NET Television’s popular series “Big Red Wrap-Up” will be right there to keep Nebraska fans updated on all of the Huskers’ gridiron action and news.

Also each week, HuskerOnline’s Sean Callahan reports on the latest recruiting news, taking a closer look at the top high school prospects who might become Huskers.
