The Perkins County Lady Plainsmen ended their season with a loss to the St Pat's Lady Irish in C-2 District Finals on Friday night in Sutherland, taking the runner-up plaque home.

"It stings a lot but they have nothing to hang their heads about," said Head Coach Penny Hite.

The Lady Plainsmen fell in five sets, 24-26, 25-22, 22-25, 25-23, 14-16 against the Irish.

Victories earlier in the week against the Lady Tigers of Bayard and the Lady Tigers of Dundy County, moved the Perkins County team into finals and a shot at the state tournament, which was not to be with the loss to St. Pat's.

"Of all the disappointments we have had this season, I can only say how proud I am of these girls," said Hite. "They kept after it and four of them were in double digits—I have always believed in their ability."
