As C-11 District Champs, the Plainsmen girls team is sending five qualifiers and one alternate to the State Track Meet at Omaha Burke Stadium this week.

Performance by the boys was just as impressive—with six qualifiers and one alternate who will participate in six state events.

Under sunny skies and mid-80s temperatures, Perkins County athletes stood out in their ability to compete for a state berth amongst the eight schools in their district during the season wrap-up hosted by Hershey on May 10.

With 84 team points, the Perkins County girls took the district title; the boys placed third with 81.5 points.

The tracksters will begin their state medal pursuit on Thursday with Class C and A running event preliminaries (except 3200 meter) beginning at 3:30 p.m. Field events for Class C also begin on Friday afternoon.
