

Registration is continuing for the SCORE (Science Camps Offer Rewarding Education) in Imperial. Director Marla Smith said the grade 5-6 camp is full, but applications are still being taken for the grade 1-2 and 3-4 camps. Final registration is June 6 at Chase County Schools.

Those 5-6 students wanting to attend the camp but not already registered are being put on a waiting list, Smith said.

The camp runs from June 13-17.

Smith has released the schedule for the grade 1-2 camp, which is June 13-15. It is as follows:
