

Wurst on spring honor roll at UW

The University of Wyoming lists 39 students from Nebraska on the 2012 spring semester academic Dean's and Dean's Freshman Honor Roll. Among those students is Joanna Wurst.

The honor roll consists of regularly enrolled undergraduates above freshman standing who earned a 3.4 or better grade point average, and freshmen who have earned a 3.25 or better grade point average.

To be eligible, students must have been enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours taken for letter grades.
