- An Oct. 19 seminar will cover Blackboard mobile, teaching online, marking up PDF files and protecting your passwords.
- Nov. 14 will cover social media including social media planning, Hootsuite, LinkedIn, Pinterest, Twitter, Facebook and TweetDeck.
- Dec. 12 will cover web development including best practices for websites, SEO and broken link checker.
