This year's car is powered by a naturally aspirated (carbureted) 454 Big Block Chevy engine, bolted to a TH 400 Turbo Automatic Transmission and coupled to a 355 Posi-trac rear-end. Special features include vintage air conditioning, power steering, power disc/drum brakes and air ride suspension.
